Change of Policy

Other information collected by NW77's website

NW77 Limited may gather a certain amount of anonymous information about users which does not personally identify you, but which may be helpful for marketing purposes or for improving the services we offer. For example we may track how many users visit a certain page, and for how long, so we can measure whether the site is effective. Generally this information is collected through "traffic data" and may entail the use of "Cookies" and "IP addresses".

Definition of "Cookie"

A "Cookie" is a message given to a web browser by a web server. Your web browser then stores the message in a text file on your computer. Each time the browser requests a page from the server, this message is sent back. A cookie's main objective is to identify users and personalise their visit by customising web pages for them for example by welcoming them by name next time they visit the same site. A site using cookies will usually invite you to provide personal information such as your name, e-mail address and interests.
